Commendations and Recommendations
2008 Five Year Interim Evaluation Report

GENERAL COMMENDATIONS

- The college is commended for the district's long-range facilities' master plan to include the Hagan Foundation Center for the Humanities and the library. The Center is a place “where people and ideas connect,” where a community of minds gather to explore various perspectives and ideas. The Center for Humanities contributes to the community’s cultural life.
- The college is commended for their commitment to the development of positive and effective working relationships with the business and industry communities.
- The college is commended for establishing their financial stewardship that has resulted in reserves that are consistent with the Board of Trustees directions.

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- The committee recommends that through a participative process involving all constituencies that the college and district implement and disseminate their coordinated strategic planning process. [Standard 1.A.1]
- The committee recommends the college clearly define part-time faculty evaluation by the use of multiple indices. Though progress has been made, there is an uneven practice across the campus. [Policy 4.1]
- The committee recommends that the A-6 agreement/contractual relationship with extended learning (IEL) constitutes a substantive change. [Standard 2.G.2, Policies A-2 and A-6]
